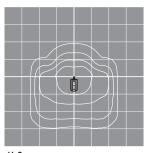
Distribution Patterns



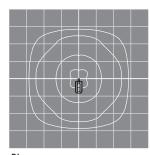
2L0 2L0 is designed to IES Type II.



3L03L0 is designed to IES Type III.

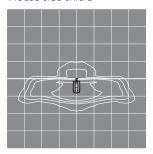

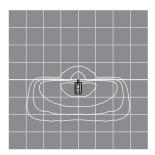

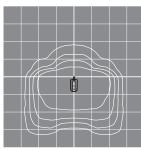
House side shield¹

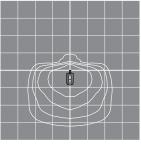

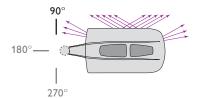

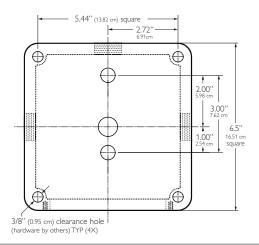

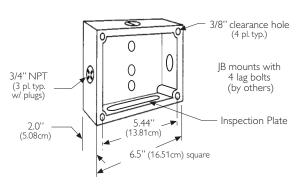
Straight and Upswept Arm Mount Drill Template # 13 (NTS)
